RULES OF PLAY

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Doubles Tournament (two Individuals per team). Maximum of 18 teams.
- 2. Double elimination. Each game will have a 25-minute max time limit with games starting every 30 minutes. Two opportunities to play, Friday, 7/25 & Saturday, 7/26. \$25/team per event.
- 3. Sign-in/Registration begins at 5:00 pm on Friday, July 25, 2025 until 5:30 pm and/or on Saturday, July 26, 2025 from 1:30 pm to 2:00 pm.
- 4. All boards and bags will be provided and set for you.
- 5. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- 6. Beer will be available for purchase to patrons 21 and older with proper identification. Beer must be consumed within the designated drinking area. ALL ID'S will be checked.

CORNHOLE BOARDS

- 1. Boards will be placed on the surface, 27 feet apart (front to front).
- 2. The board surface is 2'x4'. With a 6" hole, centered 9" from the back and 12" from the side.

CORNHOLE BAGS

- 1. There will be 8 bags per lane, 4 bags of one color and 4 of another.
- 2. Bags are regulation size and weight.

POINT SYSTEM

Traditional 21-point game with a coin toss. The winner of the coin toss chooses who pitches against whom or which side of the board to play from. The winner also decides who pitches first.

- 1. 3 points for a bag that goes through the hole whether it be thrown through, slide in or pushed in by another bag.
- 2. 1 point for a bag that lands and stays on the playing surface.
- 3. I point for a bag that is hanging in the hole but does not fall completely through.
- 4. I point for a bag that is hanging off the edge of the playing surface but is <u>NOT</u> touching the ground.
- 5. 0 points for a bag that is on the playing surface but is ALSO touching the ground.
- 6. 0 points for a bag that lands on the playing surface after touching the ground first (this bag must be removed before another bag is thrown).
- 7. 0 points for a bag that is hanging off the edge of the playing surface and is resting on another bag that is on the ground. If you can remove the bag on the ground without the one on the board falling off the board, then one point is given.

SCORING SYSTEM

- 1. Scoring will be on an honor system. If an agreement cannot be made, please notify an official.
- 2. Traditional 21-point game. Team can reach or exceed 21 points at the end. No need to win by 2.
- 3. In the event of a tie additional frames will be played until one team has more points at the end.
- 4. The approved method of scoring will be the "cancellation" scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Only one player/team will score in each inning.

GAME PLAY

- 1. Partners shall stand on opposite sides (one player throwing from right and one from left).
- 2. Each team will have 4 bags of one color.
- 3. All 8 bags will begin on one end.
- 4. A player may throw the bag in any matter they choose.
- 5. A player has 15 seconds to throw the bag.
- 6. Alternate throws between opponents are made until all 8 bags have been thrown.
- 7. Count the points during each frame until 1 team reaches or exceeds 21. The team who wins the frame throws first in the next frame. If no one scores, the last team to score throws first.

FOULS

Player loses a bag throw. Fouls include:

- 1. The thrower's foot goes past the foot foul line (front of the board).
- 2. A player goes out of turn. A player does not throw their bag within 15 seconds.
